Te Deum

W. A. Mozart (1756-1791)

Mozart's only setting of the Te Deum was written in Salzburg near the end of 1769, when he was thirteen. This was the last piece of church music he wrote before his trip to Italy in 1770 to study counterpoint under the renowned Padre Martini in Bologna. Alfred Einstein, in "Moazart, His Character, His, Work" says "... the work is constructed with a sure hand, enchanting in its choral declamation, and possessed of a certain South-German rustic grandeur even in the concluding double fugue ..."

Missa Brevis

Joseph Haydn (1732-1809)

Sometimes called the Little organ Mass because of the Benedictus for soprano and organ solos, this is a charming work full of eloquent melodies.

The heavens and the earth are full of the majesty of thy glory. The glorious chorus of the Apostles, the admirable company of the Prophets, the white-robed army of Martyrs praises thee. Throughout the whole world the holy Church gives praise to thee, the Father of infinite majesty; they praise your admirable, true, and only Son; and also the Holy Spirit, our Advocate. You are the King of glory, O Christ. You are the eternal Son of the Father To deliver us, you became human, and did not disdain the Virgin's womb. Having blunted the sting of death, You opened the kingdom of heaven to all believers. You sit at the right hand of God, in the glory of the Father. You are believed to be the Judge who will come. Therefore, we beseech you. come to the aid of your servants, whom you have redeemed by your precious blood. Make them to be numbered with thy saints in glory everlasting. Save your people, O Lord, and bless your inheritance. Govern them, and extol them from now into eternity.
