Peninsula Cantare Concert Attire Guidelines



Singers are responsible for putting together their own performance outfit using the following guidelines, color palette, and accent suggestions.

General Guidelines:

- All clothing, shoes, and accessories must match the color palette below. Any combination is
 acceptable, and not all colors have to be represented. (Simple gold/silver jewelry is ok, as long as
 it's small and doesn't reflect back into the audience's faces too much.)
- Pants or skirts or dresses should meet your shoes or be worn with black leggings/tights. (no mini-skirts; they must come past the knees)
- Tops should be elbow-length or longer.
- Shoes must be all one color, plus non-white, non-athletic, and closed-toed.
- Fabrics should be non-reflecting without glitter, sequins, or sparkle.
- Aim for business casual or nicer. No denim or athletic wear!!

Accents

- Layers are encouraged for texture and depth
- Accessories are encouraged: scarves, ties, jewelry
- Small patterns are encouraged (paisley, small flowers, geometric, etc.)
